This past year, NHMI has focused on five strategic Ministries of Hope. With the opportunity to reflect on 2015, we are astounded by how God has moved within the communities we serve.

NEW CHURCH PLANTING MISSION STATIONS WERE INITIATED IN 2016

NHMI serves as a catalyst in the process of launching, sustaining and establishing viable and culturally relevant churches in strategic locations of Muslim dominated regions of Togo, West Africa where existing congregations are maturing in the Lord and growing in number. This year, six new mission church planting stations were initiated with over 70 members. Permanent buildings are an immediate need for weekday fellowship activities and worship on Sundays.

BRIDGE OF HOPE

Children Sponsorship Program

This past year, we have witnessed miraculous intervention through fervent prayer and support from generous people like you! Our NHMI staff redoubled our commitment to prayer in 2015. We asked God to equip us as we demonstrate His love by offering the full range of services needed to eliminate poverty in 25 villages and schools.

AUXANO

Business Microfinacing Program

It is now official: Auxano was launched in Togo last year. This program exists to empower families, communities and churches through business start-up loans and the provision of integrated, holistic services. NHMI practices microloan lending in a fundamentally different way than other microfinance institutions. We want our presence to stimulate spiritual transformation and economic stabilization by creating new jobs and building small businesses that support families.

AUXANO offers training in entrepreneurship, business management, lending and assisting the development of microenterprises with entrepreneurial mentorship and spiritual discipleship that transforms lives!

SHORT TERM TRIPS & MOBILE MEDICAL MISSIONS

NHMI works with individuals and teams of all sizes to coordinate short term mission trips that are educational, fun, and life changing. At NHMI, we've received countless testimonies of eyes opened, hearts touched, and lives transformed through short term mission engagement.

Mobile Medical Clinic

Physical care is second only to spiritual care. Mobile medical clinic outreaches allow NHMI/ ACDI staff in Togo to visit Muslim dominated villages and provide medical care while sharing the love of Christ with both children and adults. This year, NHMI brought God's Word to Tabligbo, a remote village where voodoo is prevalent. Under the leadership of Dr. Scott Yagel, over 800 people received much needed services.

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

Leadership Development seminars are provided to all of our pastors and church planters to encourage growth in their knowledge of the Bible. This training also helps our leaders with little or no seminary training to gain biblical knowledge and the confidence to witness and lead their communities. In 2015 alone, NHMI conducted 6 courses at our Bible Institute (IBTAO) for 13 students.

SHARING OUR VISION

It is always NHMI's first priority to sustain current ministries and programs. When God

places an opportunity before us, we engage in prayer and seek to honor our stewardship pledge before pursuing new projects. We are excited to share a few projects where God is already leading NHMI.

Alliance Academy

Christian schools have proven to be the most effective evangelistic tool in reaching disadvantaged Muslim children and their families. Six plots of land have been purchased, and we are currently engaged in building our first Christian school, Alliance Academy. When completed, Alliance Academy will serve over 400 children. Here is what makes this school special:

• A holistic approach focusing on intellectual development, daily Bible teaching, and character development.

• Parents participate by working at the school.

• Opportunities to interact with Muslim parents and share the love of Christ.

New Bible Institute Campus

We are excited to report that construction on the administration building of the newest campus of the IBTAO is underway, as well as construction for housing and dormitories to accommodate team and staff visits. This project includes completing the chapel, additional dormitories, a library, and a kitchen. Construction is expected to be completed by 2018.



Microfinance Expansion

One of our goals for the upcoming year is to increase our micro-loan portfolio for Auxano, and to provide more loans to local entrepreneurs to build crucial business management and financial literacy skills. Our fundraising goal for this year is \$8,000. We've raised \$3,000 to date.

New Chapels for Growing Congregations

Eight congregations have expressed a need for buildings. They have already purchased land and drafted plans for a building capable of housing a congregation of 250. In addition to new church construction, we have created an evangelistic outreach program and trained new believers in spiritual formation and evangelism.

PRAYERFULLY CONSIDER PARTNERING WITH NHMI TO MEET THE NEEDS OF FIVE STRATEGIC MINISTRIES OF HOPE WITHIN WEST AFRICA COMMUNITIES.

\$5,000 to cover the living expenses of new Church planters and pastoral support.
\$5,000 to increase our micro-loan portfolio for new Christian entrepreneurs in Togo.
\$5,000 for 2 senior leadership seminars and 4-day workshops on witnessing to Muslims.
\$10,800 to provide 30 children with a solid Christian education through Bridge of Hope.
\$18,000 for the completion of a new Christian school in the middle of a Muslim village.
\$30,000 to complete Phase 1 of our new campus building project.



IN 2015:

- More than **50** vulnerable
 children and families were kept
 safe, healthy, and educated.
- Six church planting mission stations were initiated with over
 70 members.
- Over **50** candidates have trained in financial literacy and business management.
- NHMI raised \$50,000 toward building an additional Bible Institute.
- Over 800 people received critical, life-saving treatments from the Mobile Medical Clinic.
